



COURT-ORDERED COMMUNITY SERVICE

Kitchens for Good offers opportunities for court-ordered volunteers to complete service hour requirements through our volunteer programs.

Candidates seeking to fulfill court-required service at Kitchens for Good must have misdemeanor charges only. Felonies, violent crimes, domestic abuse charges are not allowed. Registered sex offenders are also not permitted to complete service.

Volunteer Registration Process:

- 1) Please call or email our Volunteer Coordinator (858-472-8413; nina@kitchensforgood.org) to schedule a face-to face volunteer orientation at least 7 business days before your potential start date. Potential volunteer must disclose their charge to the Volunteer Coordinator during the initial email or phone call.
- 2) At the volunteer orientation, the Volunteer Coordinator will communicate Kitchen for Good's expectations and the participant will commit to adhering to these policies by signing the KFG Volunteer Agreement. Participants will collaborate with the Volunteer Coordinator to a set schedule for volunteer shifts and receive a timesheet to keep track of KFG volunteer hours.
- 3) After completing the required hours, the volunteer will submit the timesheet to the Volunteer Coordinator for review. Upon approval of the timesheet, Kitchens for Good will provide a letter of completion and confirmation of the number of hours completed.

The opportunity to complete court-ordered service can be terminated at any time due to failure to abide by Kitchen for Good's policies. Grounds for discontinuation of service will be clearly outlined during the volunteer orientation.
