



COURT-ORDERED COMMUNITY SERVICE

Kitchens for Good offers opportunities for court-ordered volunteers to complete service hour requirements through our volunteer program. Violent crimes and domestic abuse charge recipients are not eligible to complete service with Kitchens for Good. Additionally, registered sex offenders are also not permitted to participate. Like other volunteers, the opportunity to complete court-ordered service can be terminated at any time due to failure to abide by Kitchen for Good's policies (as outlined in the Volunteer Handbook).

Volunteer Registration Process:

- 1) Please call or email our Volunteer Coordinator (858-472-8413; nina@kitchensforgood.org) and indicate the number of community service hours needed.
- 2) After completing the required hours, the volunteer will submit the timesheet to the Volunteer Coordinator for review. Upon approval of the timesheet, Kitchens for Good will provide a letter of completion and confirmation of the number of hours completed.
