These enterprises include a robust catering and events operations, contract meal services, and activities conducted in enterprise kitchens. Position Summary: The maintenance coordinator is responsible for a wide range of duties that vary in complexity such as executing event set-ups, custodial duties in office and event room, and general upkeep of location.

Essential Functions:

Event Setup and breakdown

- Read banquet and event order (BEO) and diagrams for event set up
- Responsible for clearing event rooms and areas in preparation for subsequent functions which includes: stacking of chairs, tables, and thoroughly cleaning of all such areas and equipment
- Dismantles and reassembles equipment and stage according to event details
- Clean-up of all function areas used for private events and public areas

Janitorial

- Sweeps, vacuums, mops, scrubs, waxes, and polishes floors using industrial vacuum cleaners and scrubbing buffing machines.
- Sometimes using ladders, dusts and washes walls, cleans ceilings and dust and polishes light fixtures.
- Moves cabinets, boxes, furniture, crates, and equipment to clean areas. May remove stains from such surfaces as rugs, drapes, walls, and floors using chemicals and cleaning solutions.
- Responsible for the inventory of janitorial supplies and equipment and order/purchase supplies as needed while adhering to departmental budget
- Clean and sanitize all bathrooms which include office and banquet hall
- Adhere to provided safety requirements
- Adhering to the facilities and maintenance schedule

Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception and ability to adjust focus.

Employee may be expected to travel to scheduled off-site events and/or locations.
