SUMMARY + PURPOSE

Every Wednesday morning, our Food Rescue Volunteer uses their car to pick up produce from a Mobile Food Pantry Truck in Barrio Logan.

The produce delivered by volunteers is used by our students to practice their culinary skills and later prepared into healthy meals for hunger relief agencies.

TIME + ACTIVITIES

TIME: Wednesdays, 8am-9am

COMMITMENT: 3 months; weekly or biweekly

- Driving to mobile pantry site and Kitchens for Good
- Lifting 50+ lbs
- Collaborating with KFG staff on logistics

QUALIFICATIONS

- Ability to provide proof of automobile insurance
- Ability to lift 50 pounds and have access to a cell phone
- Must be punctual -- distribution starts promptly at **8:00am sharp**

SUMMARY + PURPOSE

On a weekly basis, our Food Rescue Volunteer uses their personal vehicle to pick up produce from the Jacobs and Cushman San Diego Food Bank in Sorrento Valley. After arriving to the site, the Volunteer collects the desired items into plastic milk crates and then returns to the Kitchens for Good facility.

TIME + ACTIVITIES

TIME: Mondays at 1:15PM

COMMITMENT: 3 months / weekly or biweekly

- Driving and communicating with partner agencies and KFG chefs
- Collecting produce on-site and packing it into crates

QUALIFICATIONS

- Proof of automobile insurance
- Ability to lift 50 pounds and have access to a cell phone
- Must be punctual, courteous, and prioritize safe driving practices
- Closed-toe shoes are required

SUMMARY + PURPOSE

Every Wednesday morning, our Volunteer Driver picks up 500+ lbs. of donated product from Specialty Produce's "Waste Not SD" food rescue program. Upon its arrival to our facility, the "Waste Not SD" Sort Volunteers help us clean, sort, and weigh the produce. The produce donated is used in our hunger relief meals.

TIME + ACTIVITIES

TIME: Wednesdays, 10am-12:00pm
COMMITMENT: "drop-in" / one-time

- Sorting and cleaning produce
- Weighing donations

QUALIFICATIONS

- Ages 16 and up only
- Must be able to lift 50+ lbs.
- Closed-toe, no-slip shoes are required
- It can be a **messy** task -- please wear clothing that can get dirty
- Orientation is provided on-site at the start of each session
